JANUARY MEETING

The January meeting was held on Tuesday, January 10, 1967 at the home of Mr. and Mrs. J. Woodford with 19 members in attendance. W. Wasserfall was the chairman. An announcement of the annual general meeting was made by D. Baldwin. A report on the progress of the incorporation of the L.P.B.O. was given by J. Woodford. A summary of the Christmas Census at Long Point, on which 18585 birds of 88 species were seen, was presented by J. Miles.

The speaker of the evening was Mr. Bill Carrick who is Managing Director of the Niska Waterfowl Research Station and the Kortright Waterfowl Park. He was introduced by J. Woodford. Mr. Carrick described the way in which the station was established. It consists of the park area where many species of waterfowl and other birds are on display and the research area. The facilities for studying waterfowl are used by students from several universities. He showed some movies of Niska and also two of his excellent films on waterfowl.
